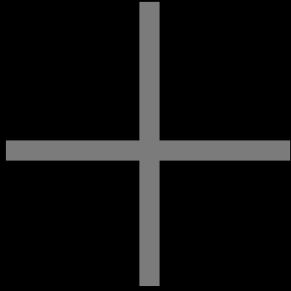


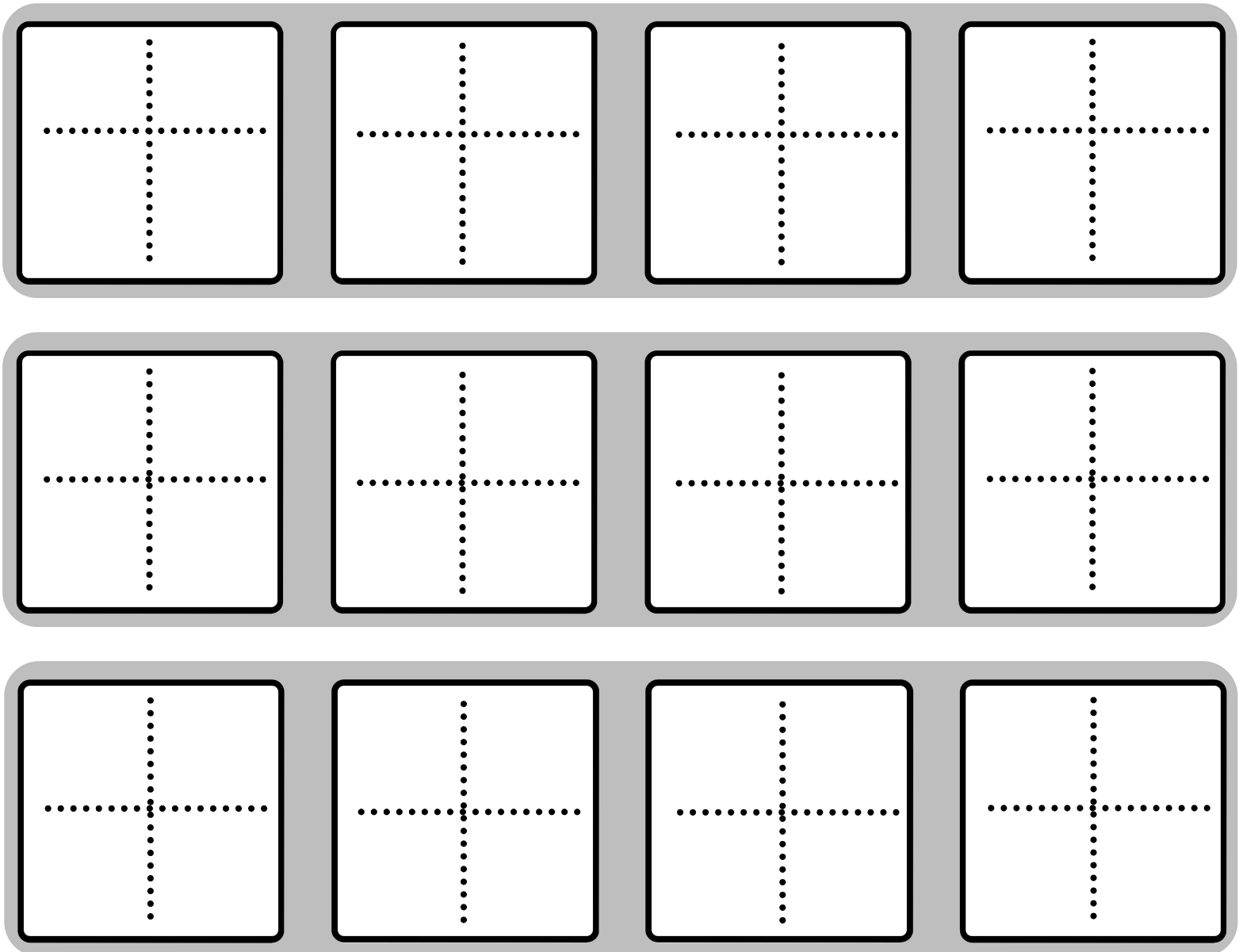

The Cross/Plus Sign (Part Two)

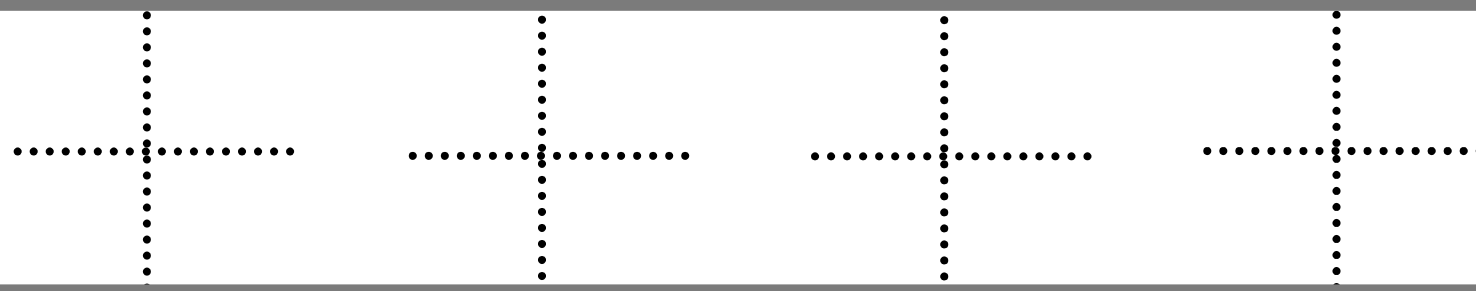
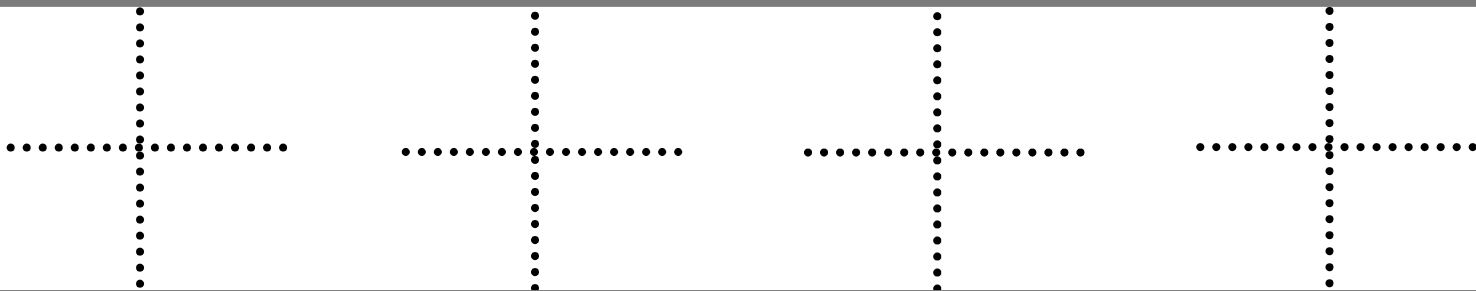


Let's do some more practice
with our cross (plus) sign!

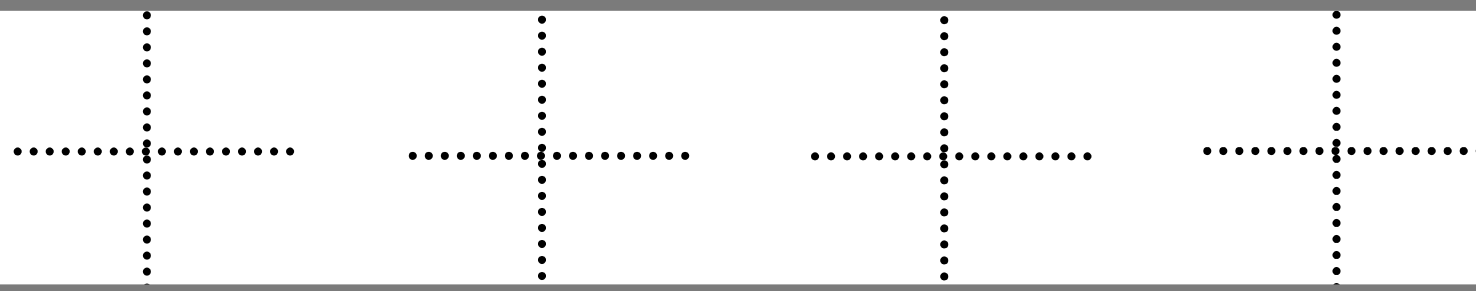
Trace the lines below. Remember to start at the top and go down.
Then start on the left and go to the right.



Good job! Keep tracing the cross (plus) signs!

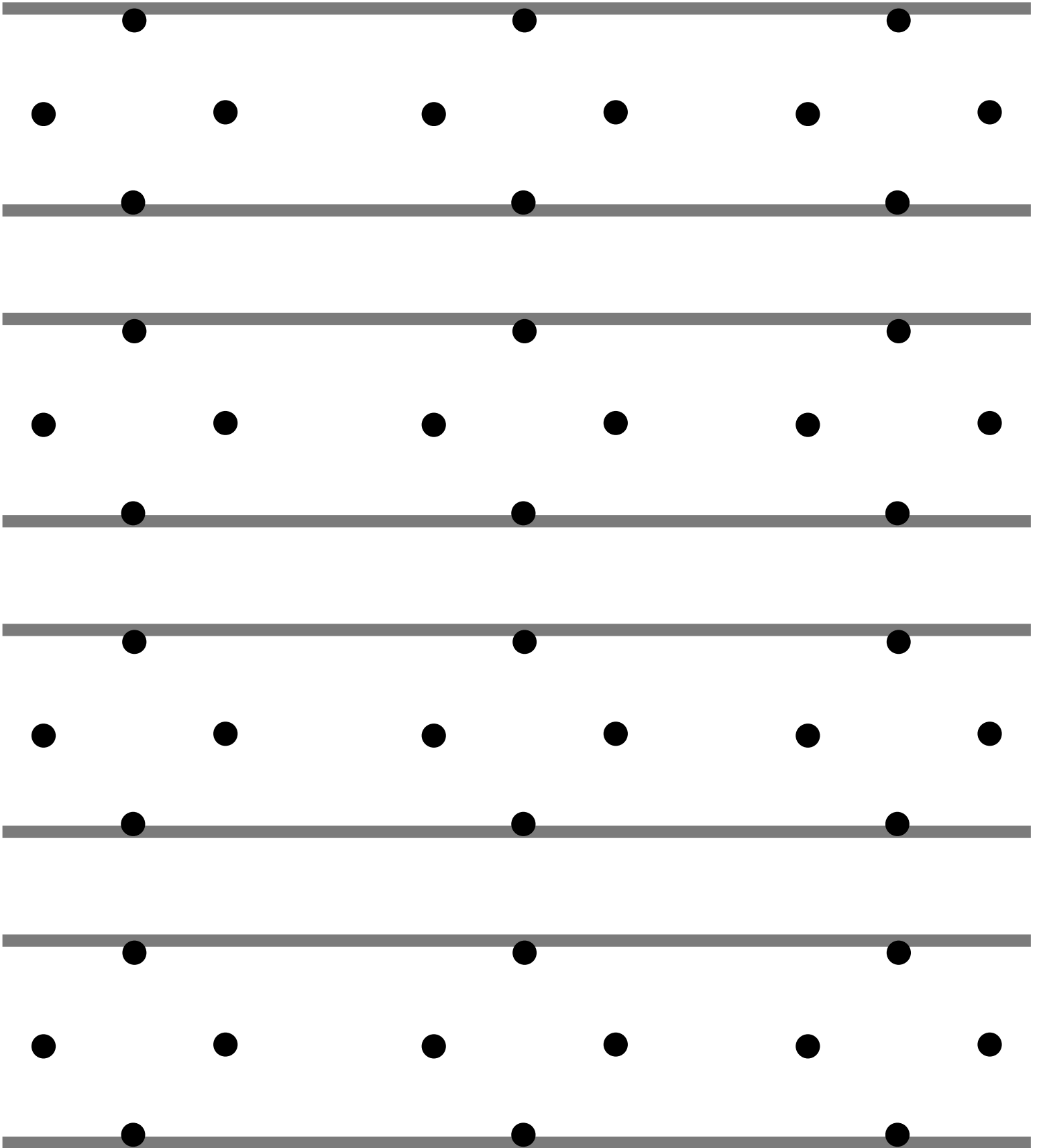


Nice work! Try your best to stay inside of the purple lines!



Now let's draw our cross (plus) signs!

Draw a line from the top dot down to its matching bottom dot.
Then draw a line from the left dot over to its matching right dot.



Way to go! You're almost done!
Let's practice drawing just a few more cross (plus) signs!

The worksheet contains five identical sets of handwriting practice lines. Each set includes a top line, a middle line, and a bottom line. On each of these three lines, there are three black dots: one at the left end, one in the center, and one at the right end. These dots are intended to help children practice drawing plus signs (+) by connecting the dots on each line.
