The Square (Part One)

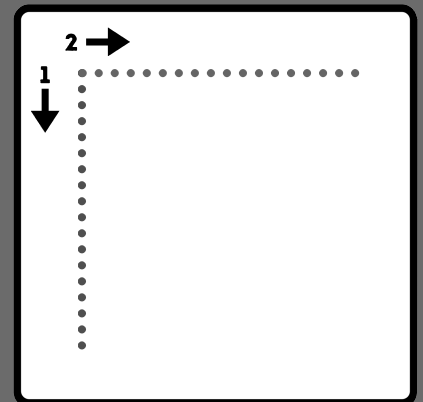
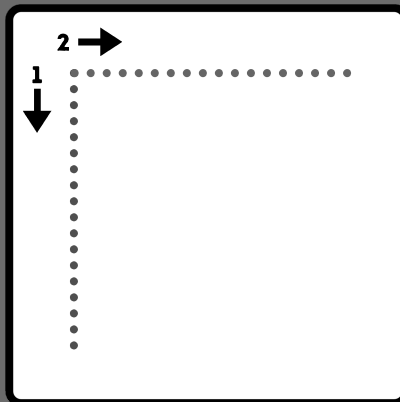
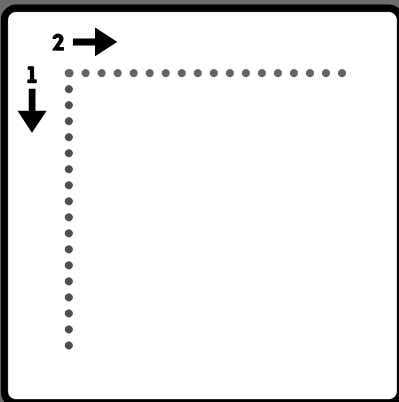


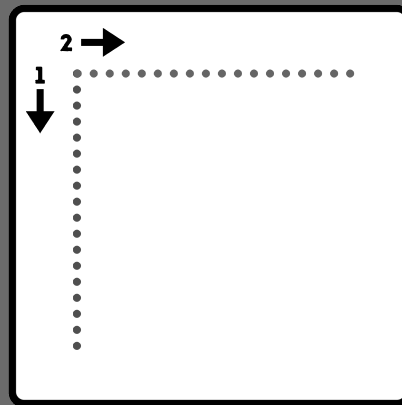
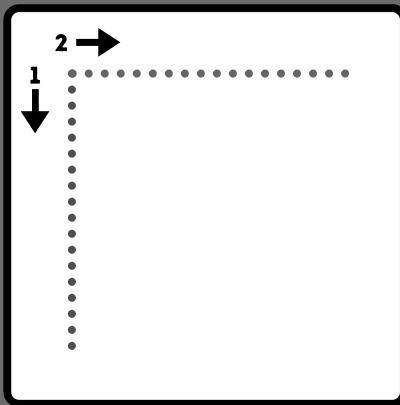
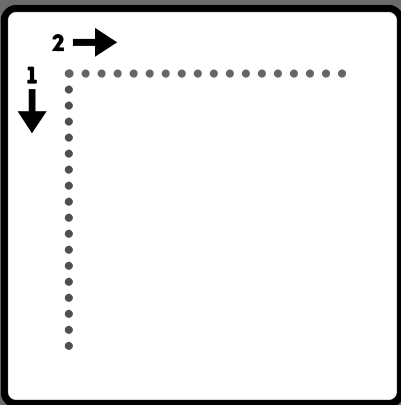
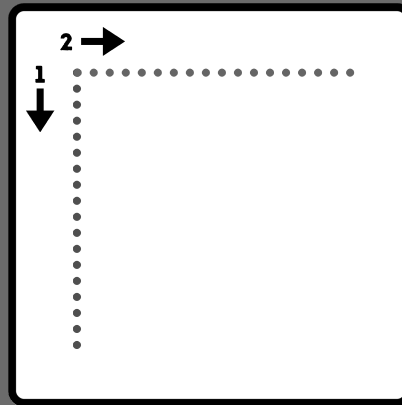
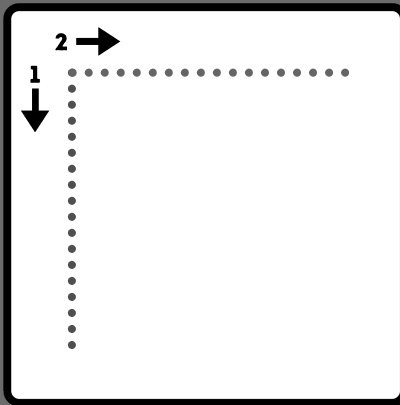
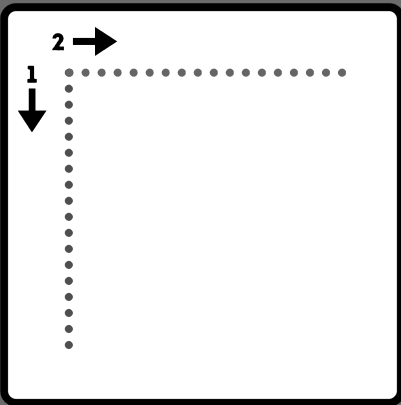
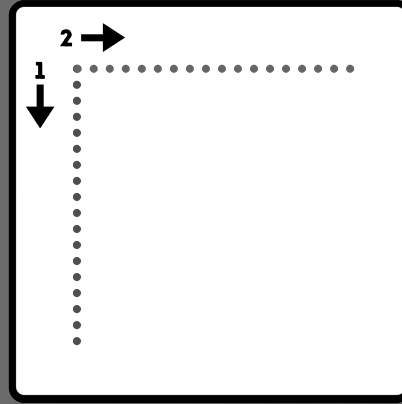
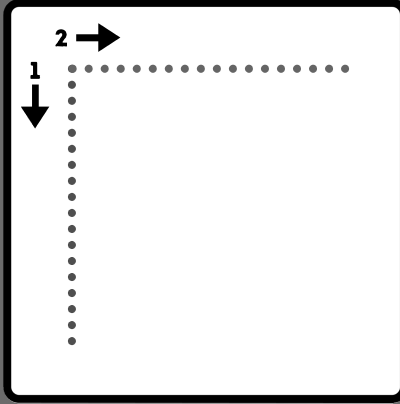
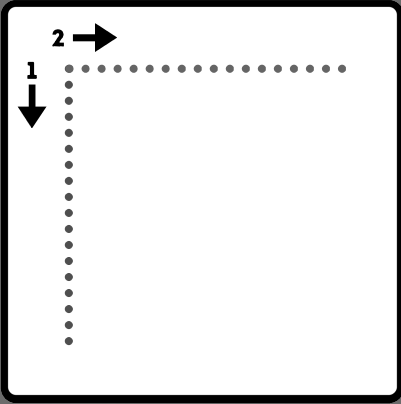
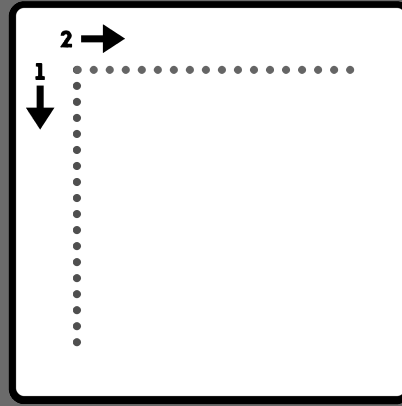
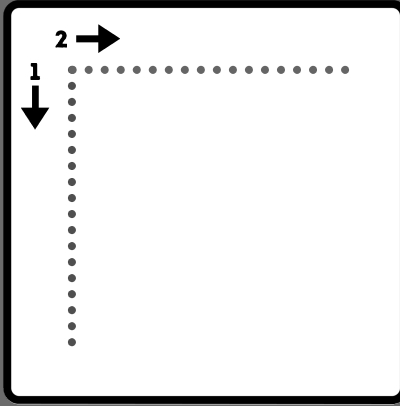
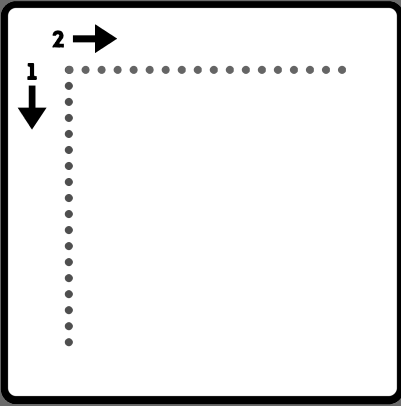
We learned how to put two lines together. Now let's put FOUR lines together and make a square!

Let's trace the first line of our square. Start at the top and then go down.



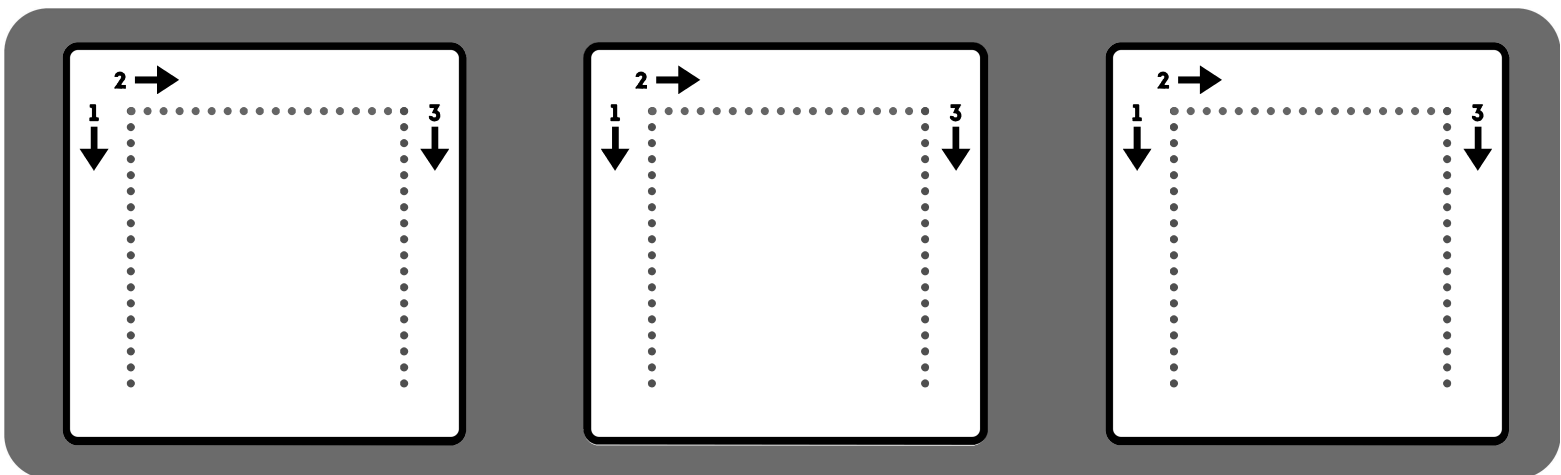
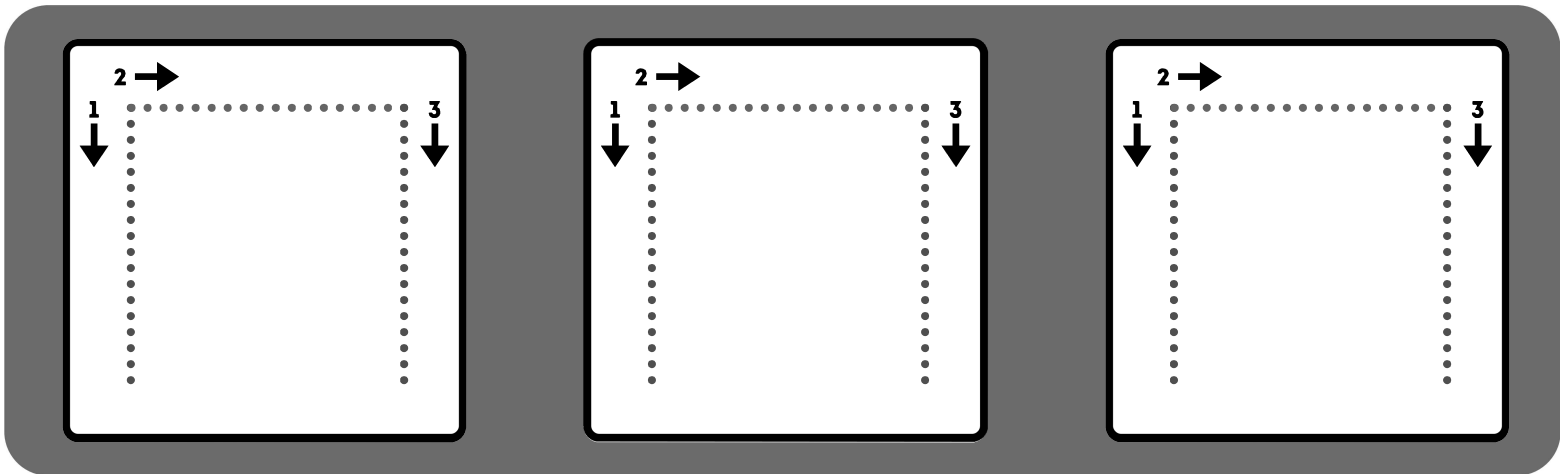
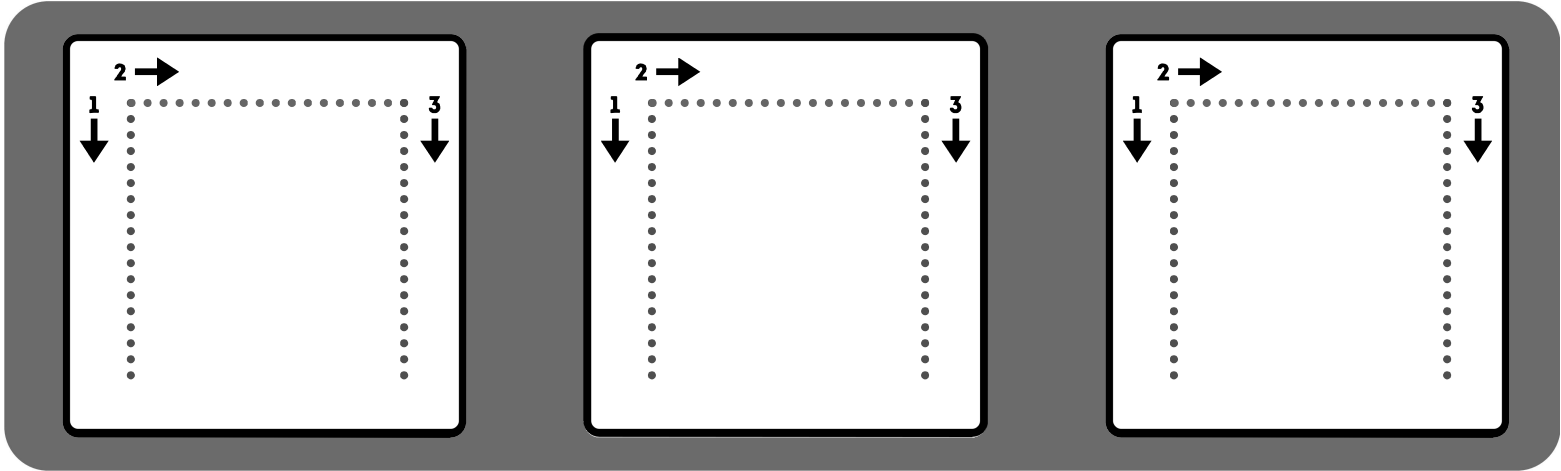
Now let's trace two lines of our square. Start at the top and go down. Then start at the top again and go to the right.





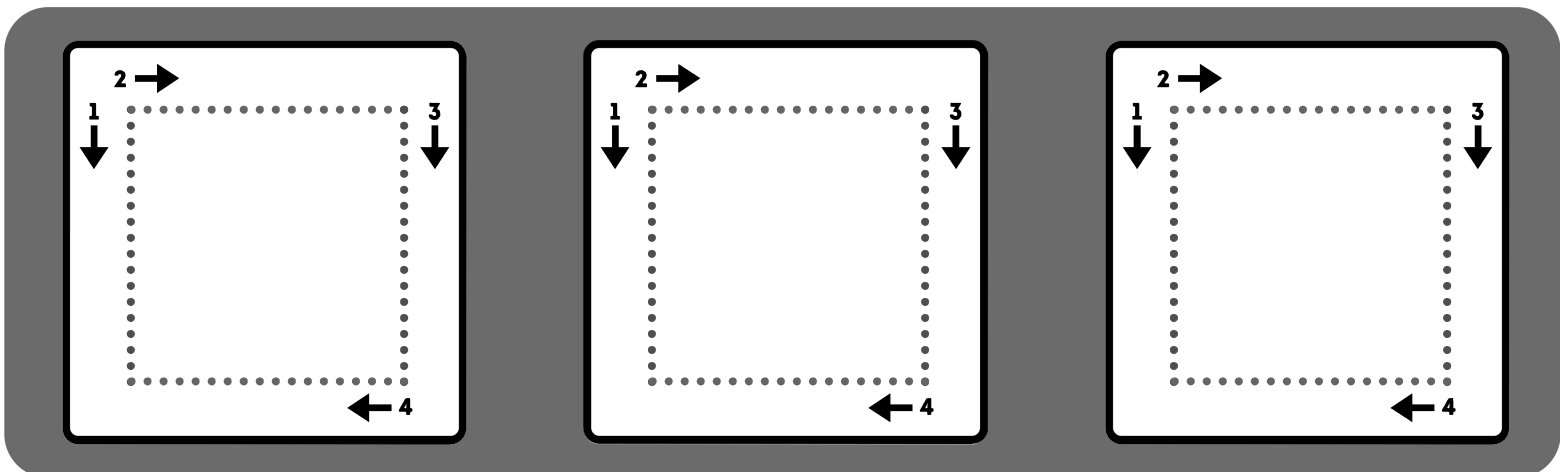
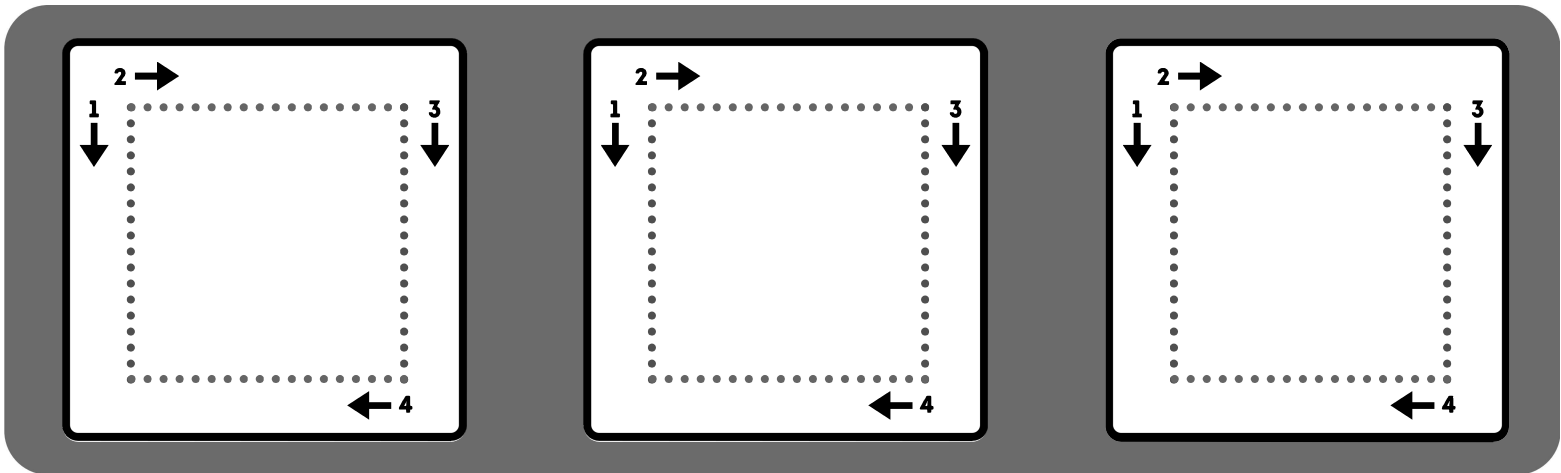
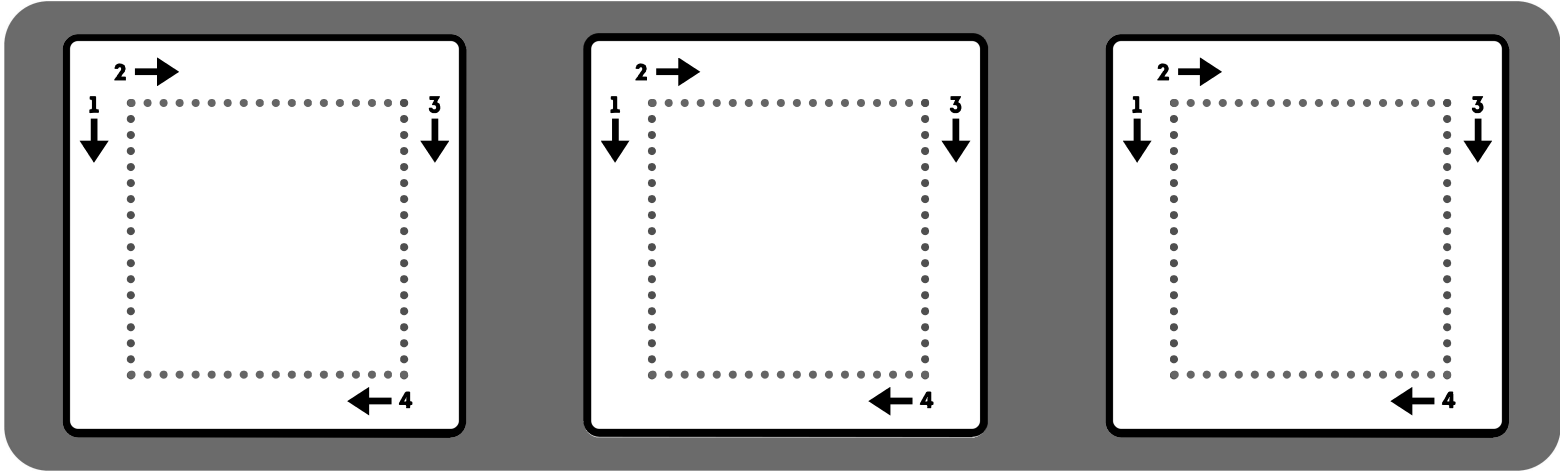
You're doing a really good job! You're halfway there to get your square!

Are you ready to trace the next line? Let's do it! Trace your first line: start at the top and go down. Trace your second line: start at the top and go right. Your new line will start where your second line stopped. This is also the top; it's just on the other side! Start there and go down.



Nice work! Now let's finish tracing our square!

Trace your first line: start at the top left side and go down. Trace your second line: start at the top left side and go right. Trace your third line: start at the top right side and go down. And finally, trace your fourth line: start at the bottom right (where your third line stopped) and go left.



Wow! You did it! Now let's trace our squares with black lines and no numbers!
