

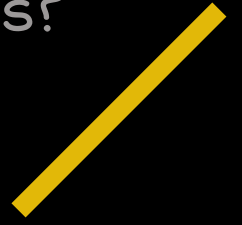
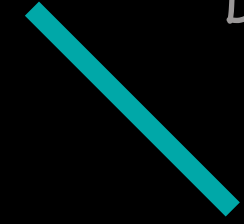

Right and Left Diagonal Lines

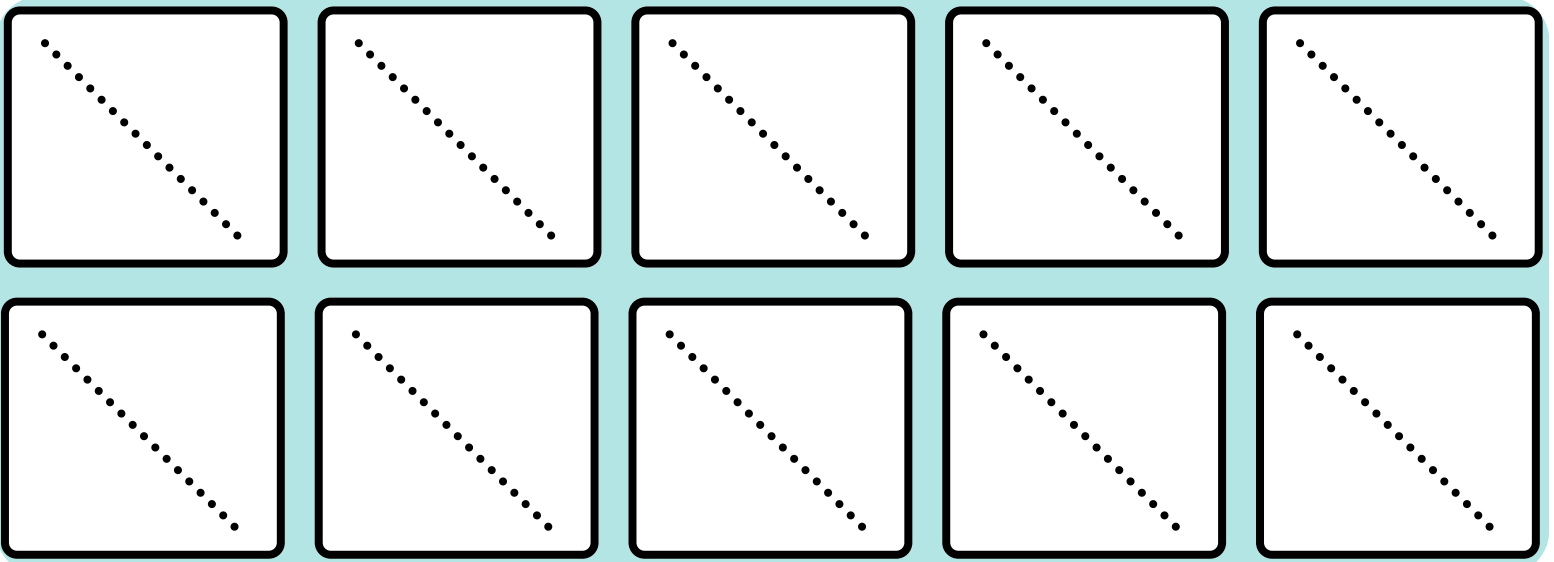

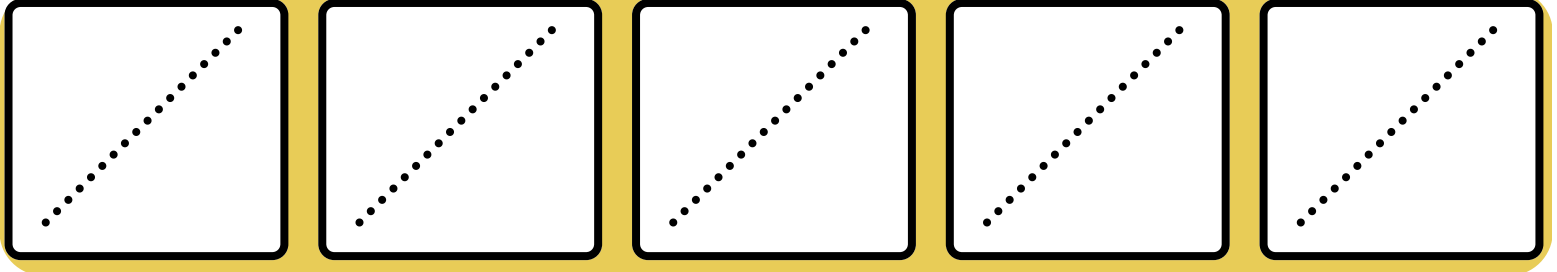
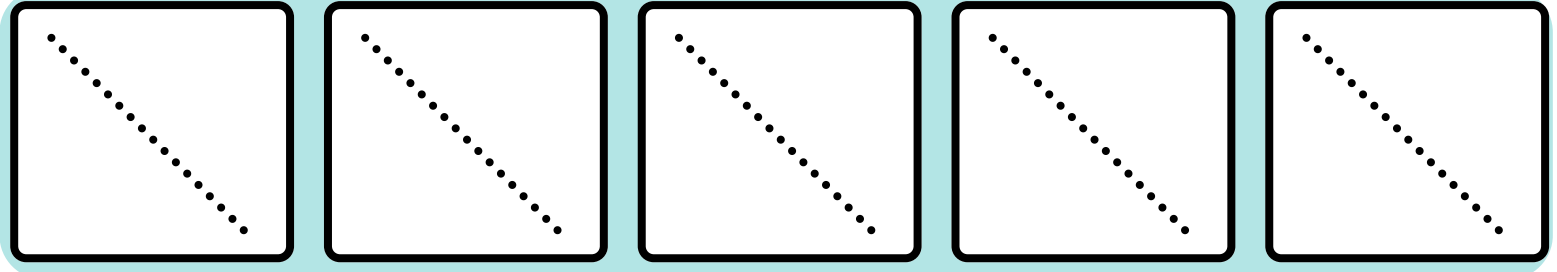
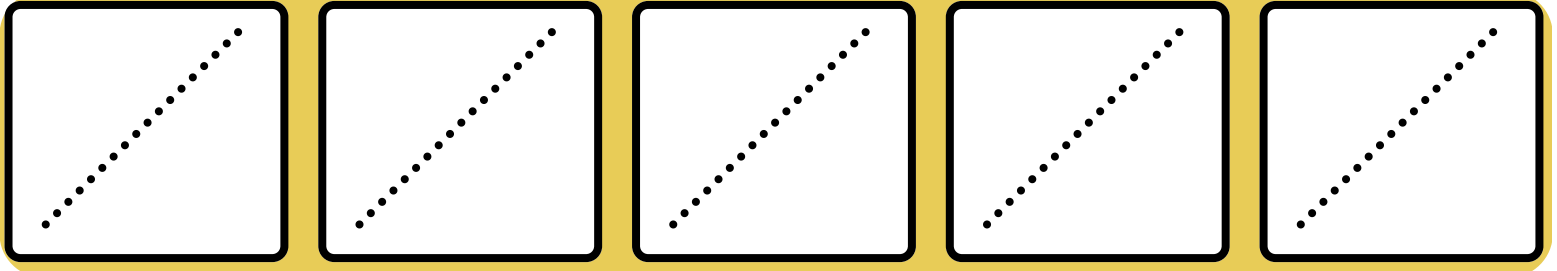
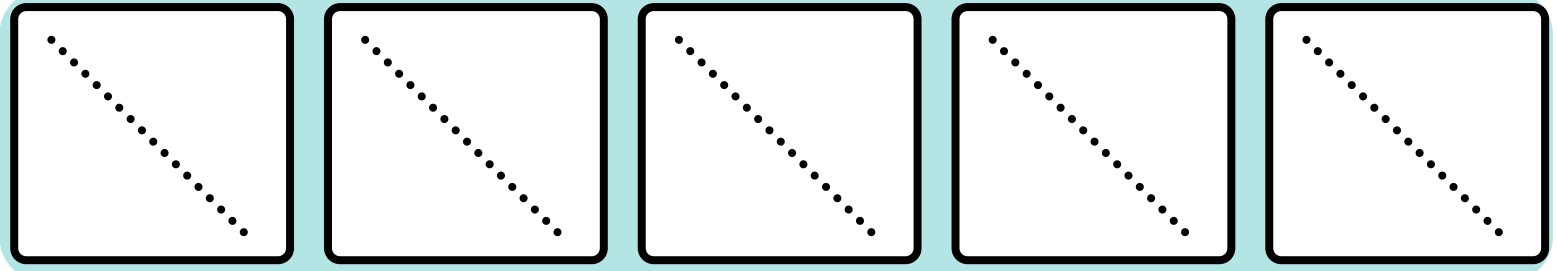
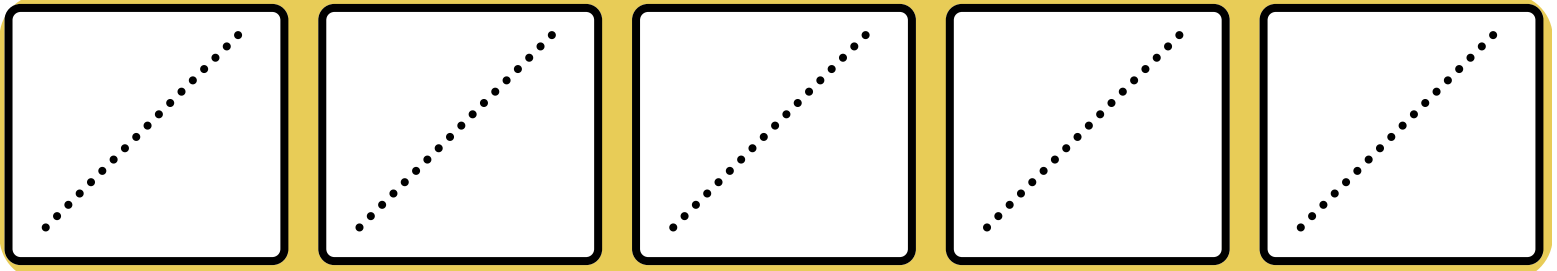
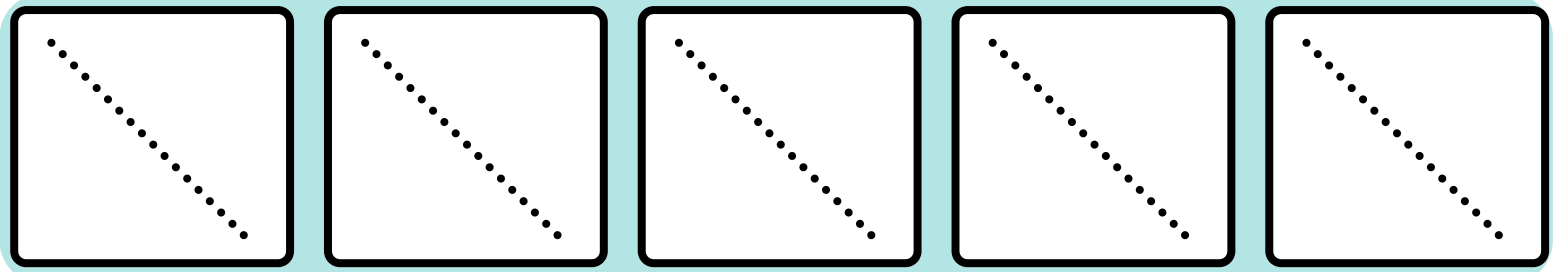
Let's trace our right diagonal lines! Remember to start at the top and go down to the right.



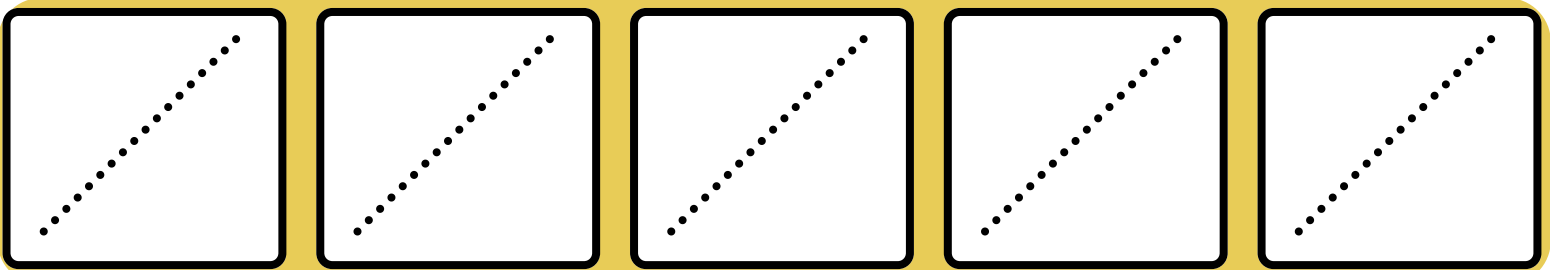
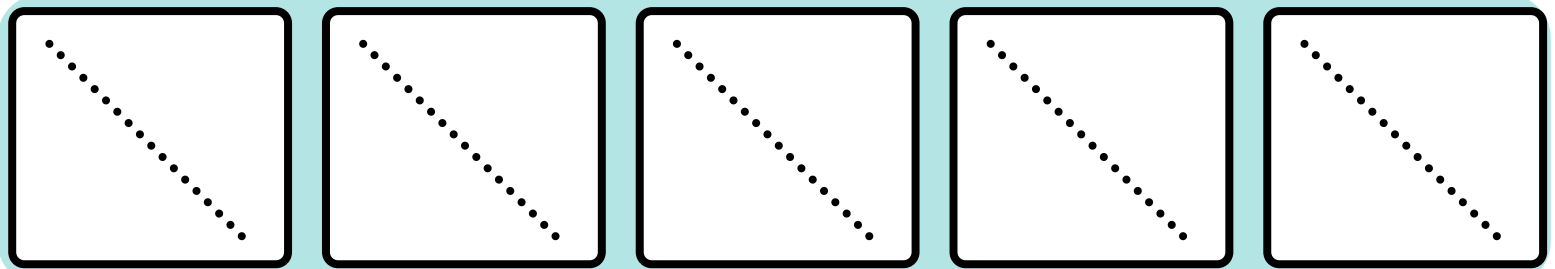
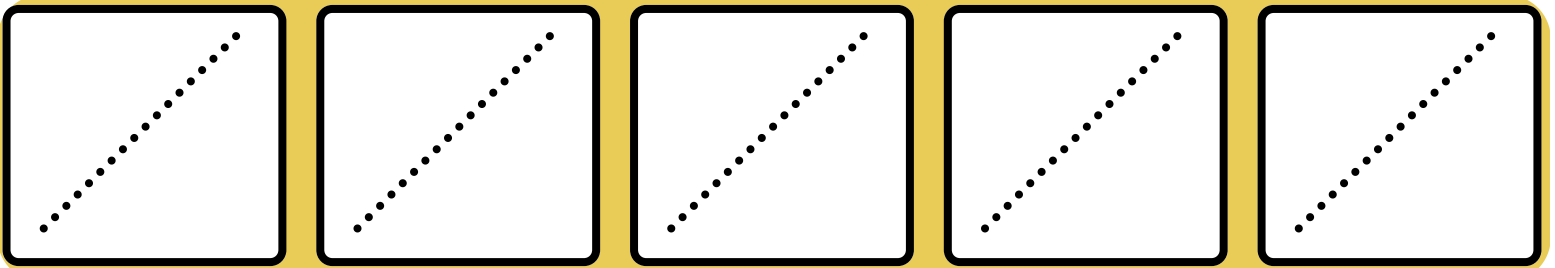
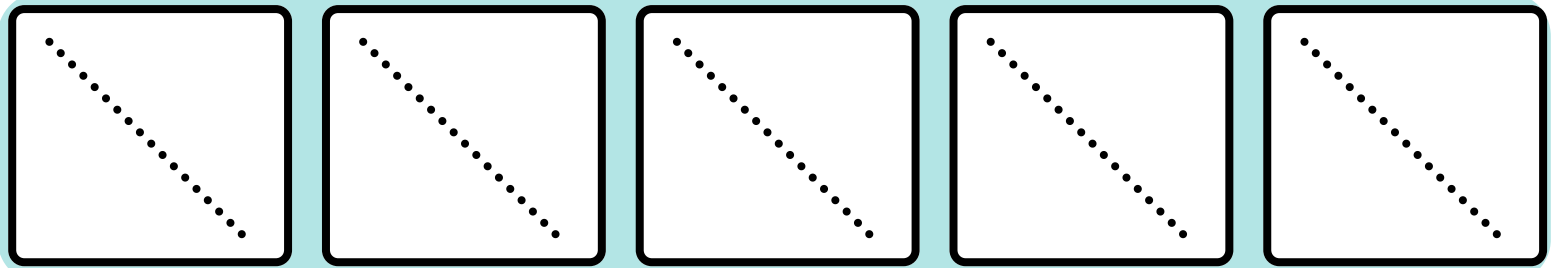
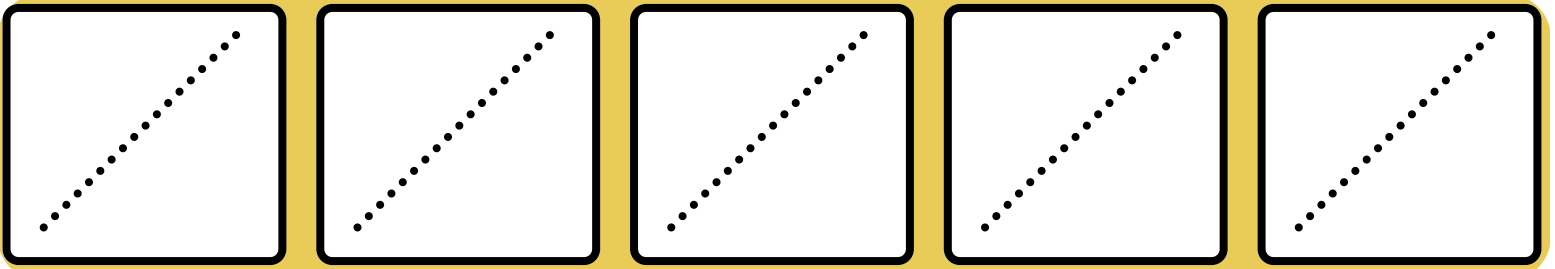
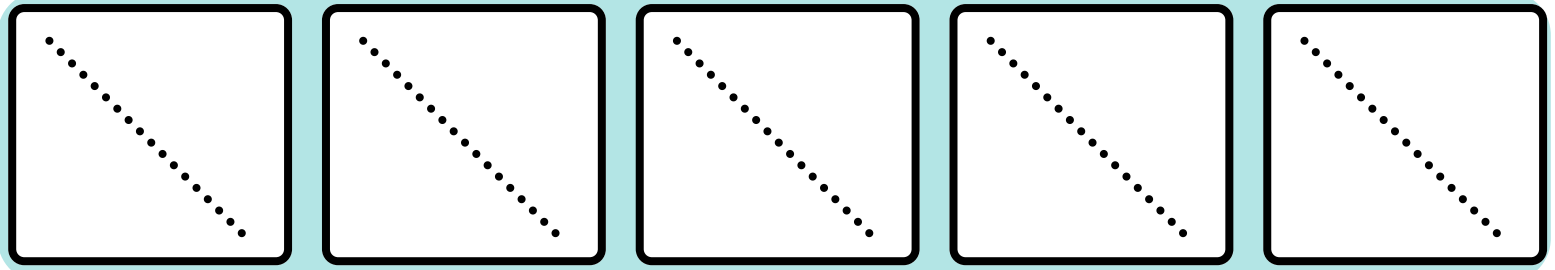
Let's trace our left diagonal lines! Remember to start at the top and go down to the left.



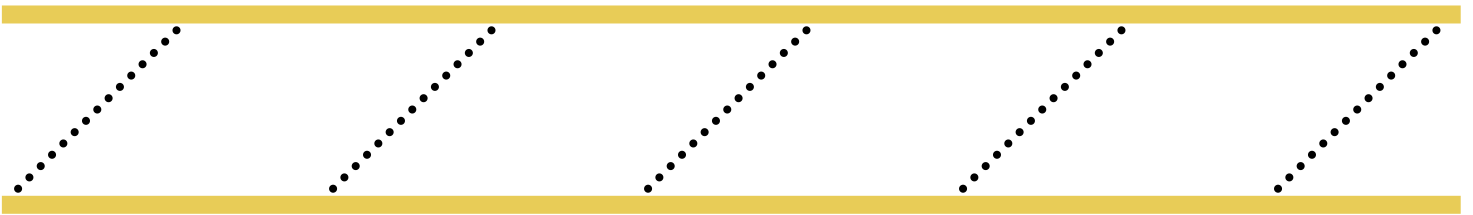
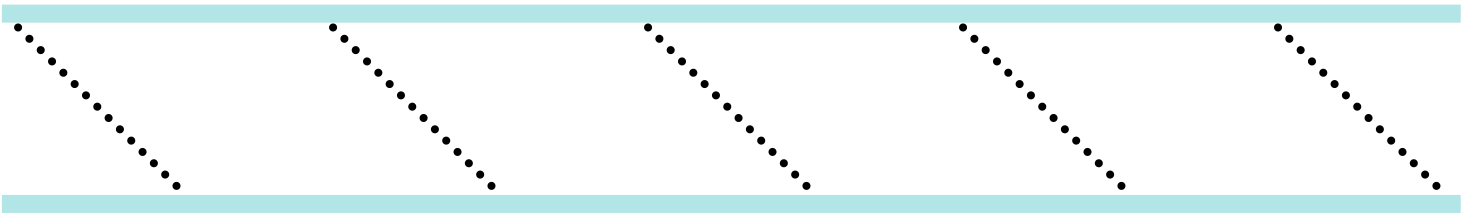
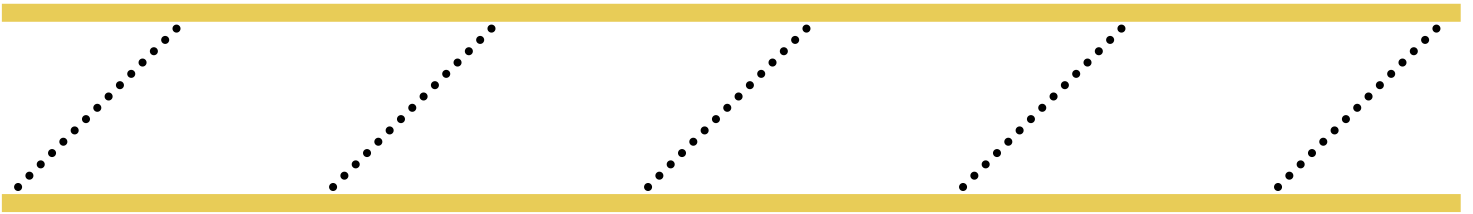
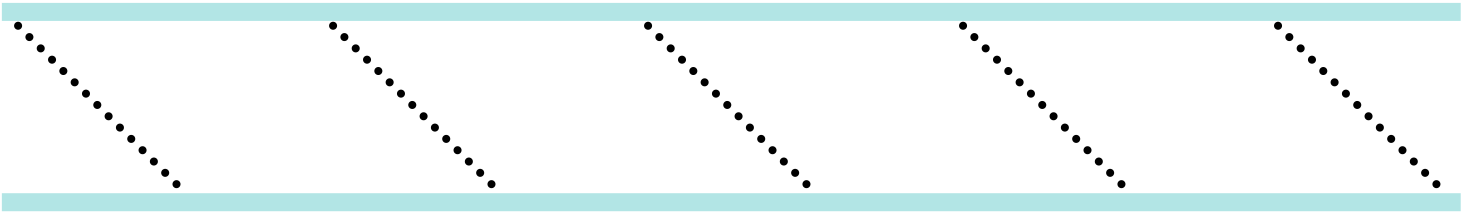
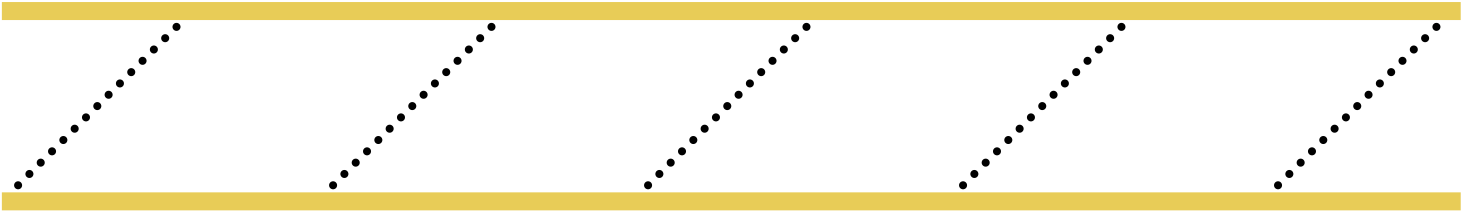
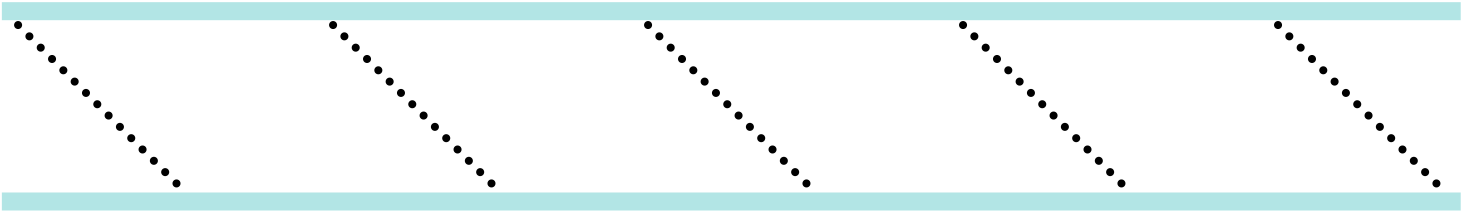
Way to go! Trace the lines below.
