## The Instructions:

## Challenge Suggestions

- Make a card game if you don't have much time for your date or make a board game if you have more time.
- Cut out cards from printer paper, notebook paper, or cardstock, and hand each member a certain amount of cards. On these cards, they can write questions about themselves that other family members have to answer.
- For the board game, you could paste various pictures of family members all around the edge of the board (think Monopoly-style board) and gather small things around your house (or make) tokens to "travel" around the board. Each player could then roll dice, land on a picture, and answer a question about that family member. If someone answers incorrectly, you can make up some kind of rule for them to do something (like move back two spaces).
- Spice things up: Add extra things to your board or card/board pictures. Make up fun rules where players have to do or answer various different things. Make easy, medium, and difficult questions about family members.
- Laugh and enjoy each other's company while making and playing this game!
