

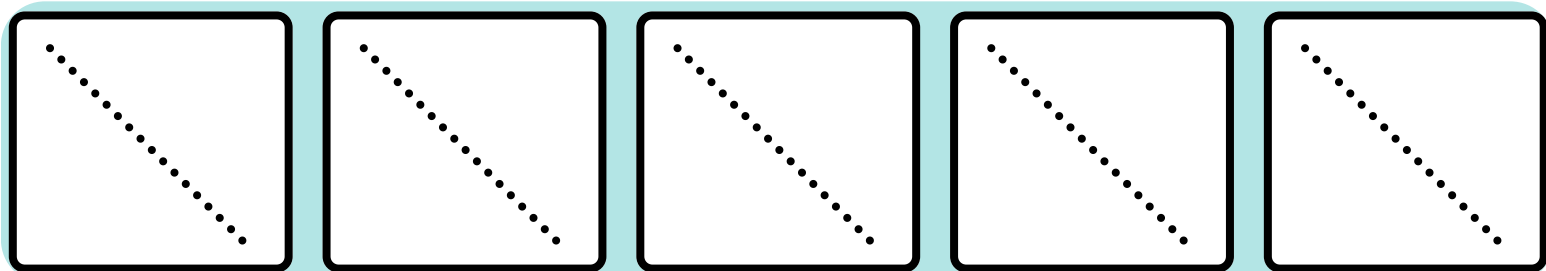

## The X Shape (Part One)

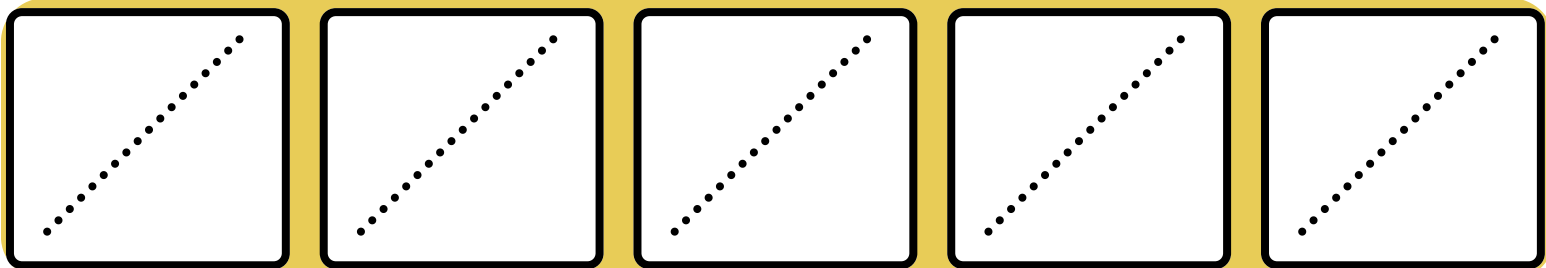


Let's put our diagonal lines together!  
Now we have the X shape!

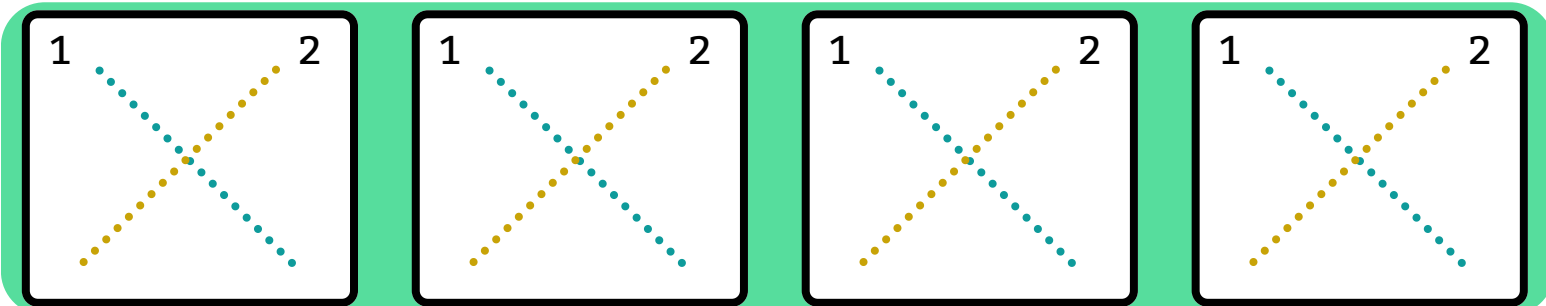
Let's trace our right diagonal lines! Remember to start at the top and go down to the right.



Let's trace our left diagonal lines! Remember to start at the top and go down to the left.



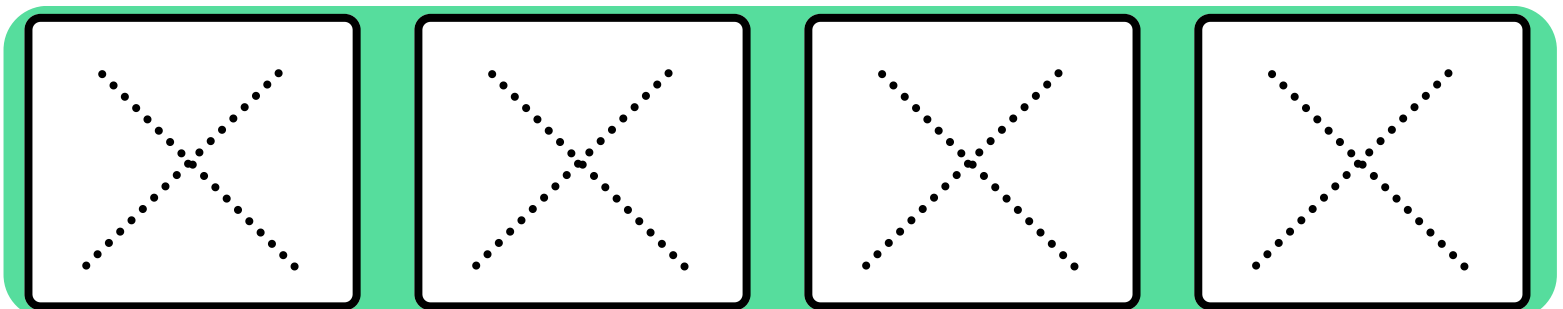
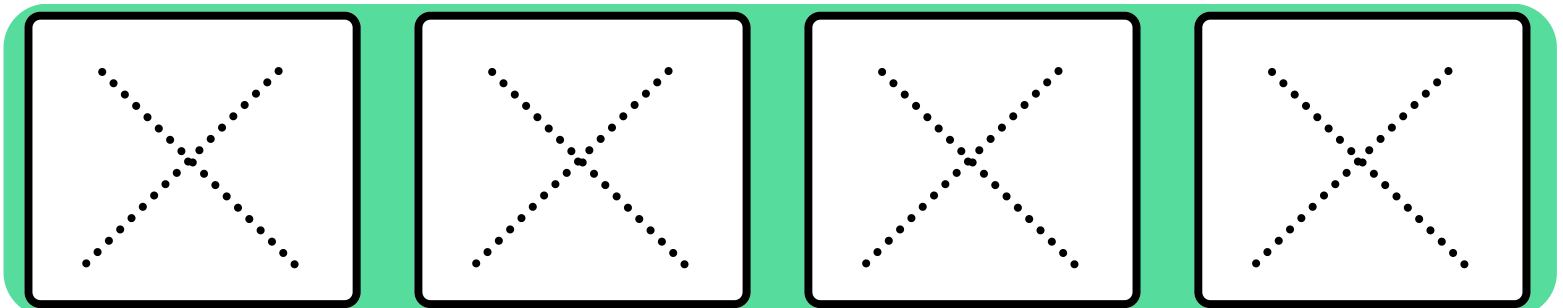
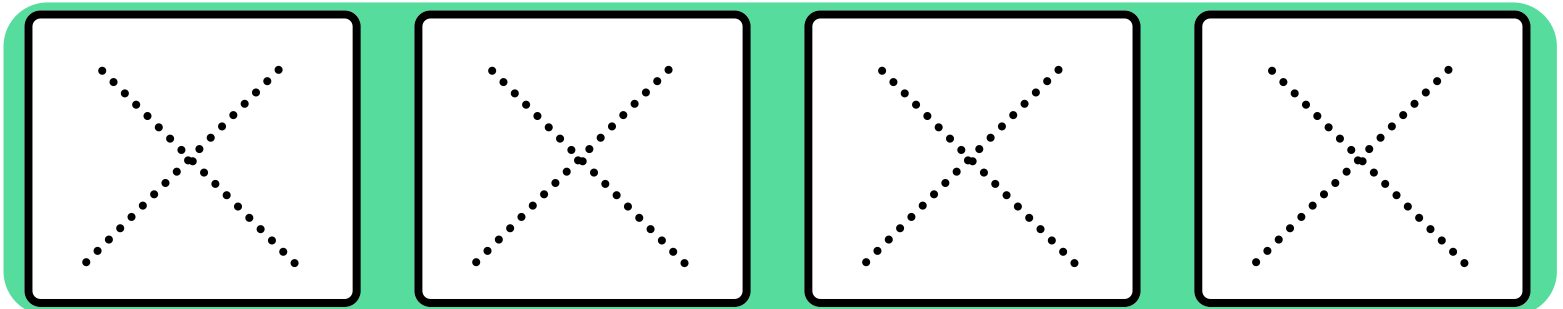
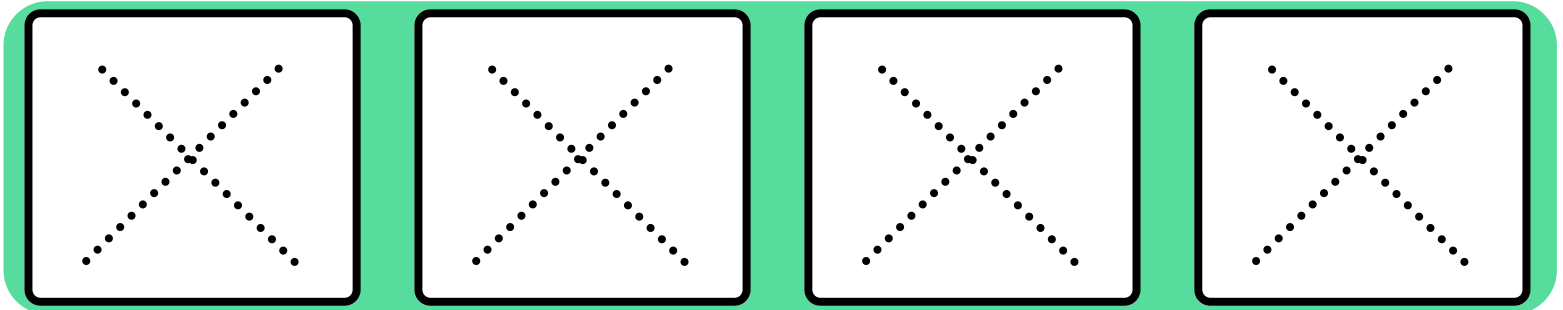
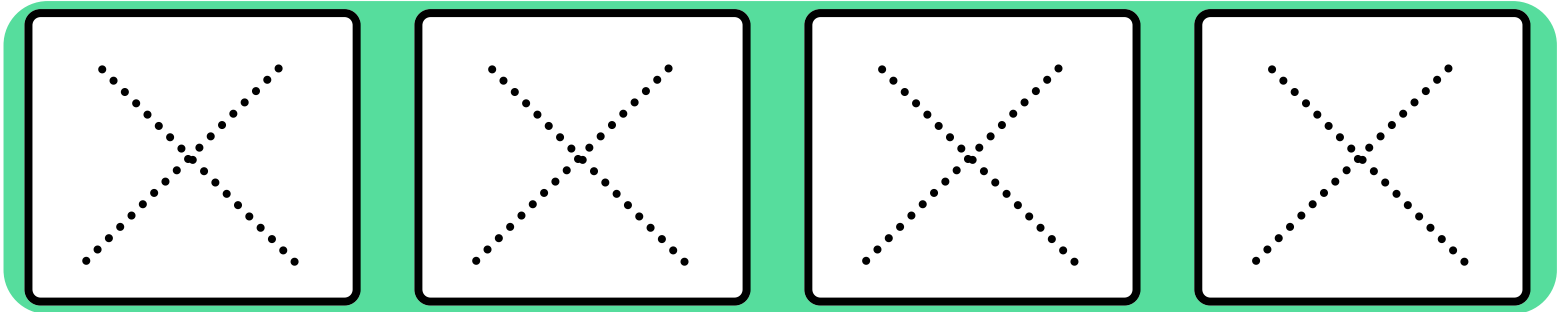
Let's make the X shape! Trace the right diagonal line first. Start at the top and go down to the right. Then trace the left diagonal line. Start at the top and go down to the left.



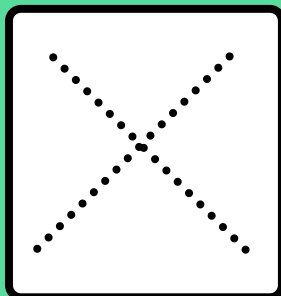
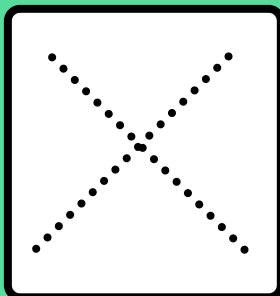
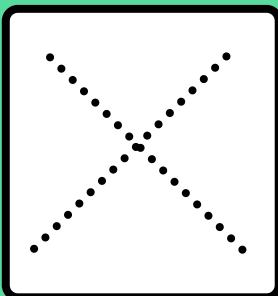
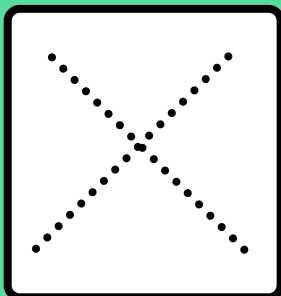
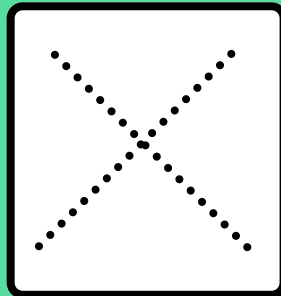
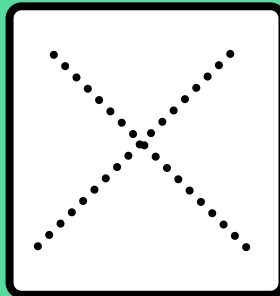
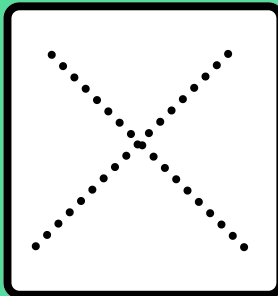
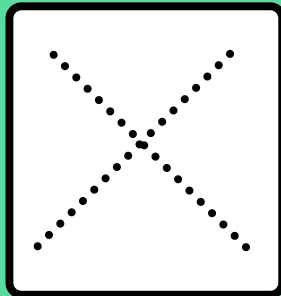
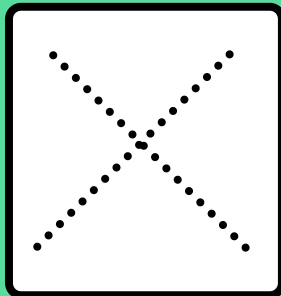
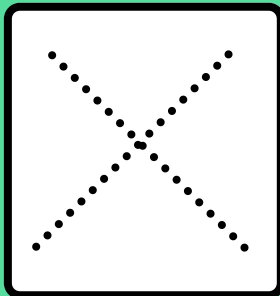
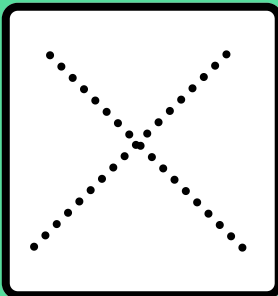
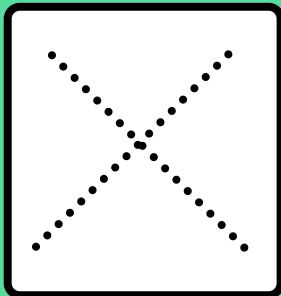
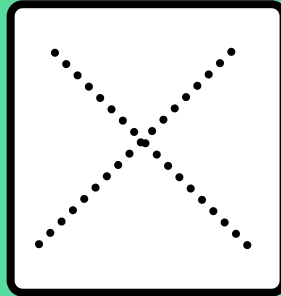
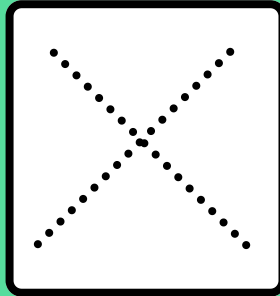
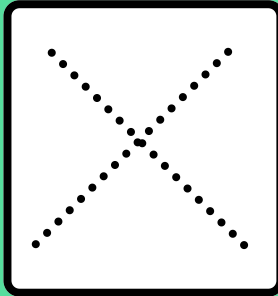
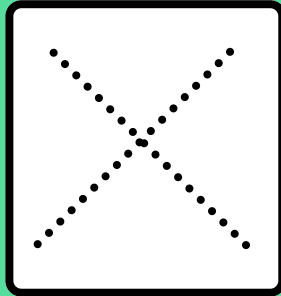
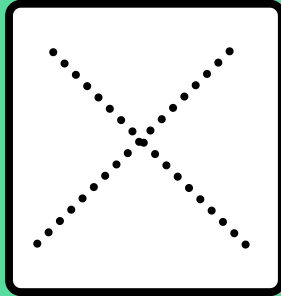
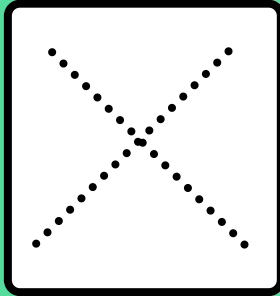
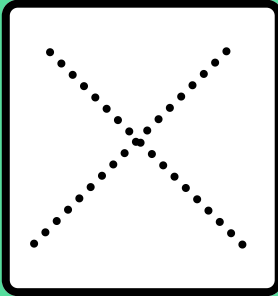
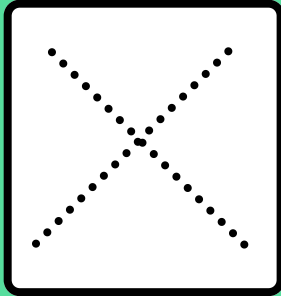
Great work! Keep going!
