

Curved Lines (Part Three): The Circle




When we put our two curved lines together, we get a circle! A circle is one long curved line. Let's make a circle!

Trace the circles below! Trace them with your finger first. Then trace them with your pencil. Start at the dot and go down to the left. Keep going around until you get to the dot again.












Now trace the circles without a helping dot. Start at the top and go all the way around!












Now let's draw our circle! Start at the top dot and go down to the next dot, on around to the bottom dot, up to the next dot, and back up to the top dot again.





Let's try drawing our circles with only two dots now! Start at the top dot, draw a curved line down to the bottom dot, and dont' stop! Keep that line going and head back up to the top dot!
