



















Now let's learn how to make curved lines!
Can you make this shape with your hand?







Let's trace this curved line! First, trace each one with your finger. Then trace with your pencil.
Start at the top (right) and go down to the bottom (right).




Fantastic work! Keep going!



Now trace our shapes in between the pink lines!

Let's draw our shapes! Start at the top dot and draw a curve down to the next dot.
