Curved Lines (Part Two)



This is another curved line.

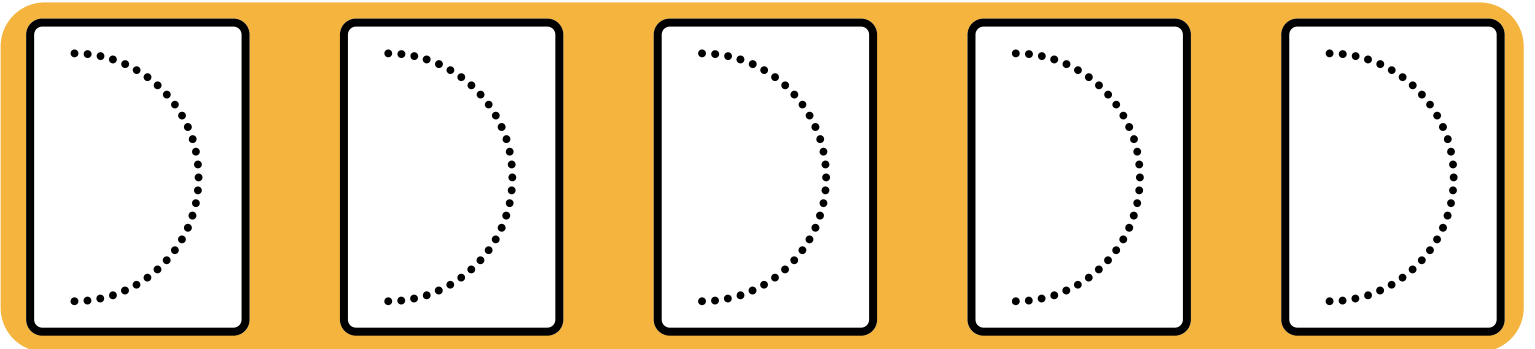
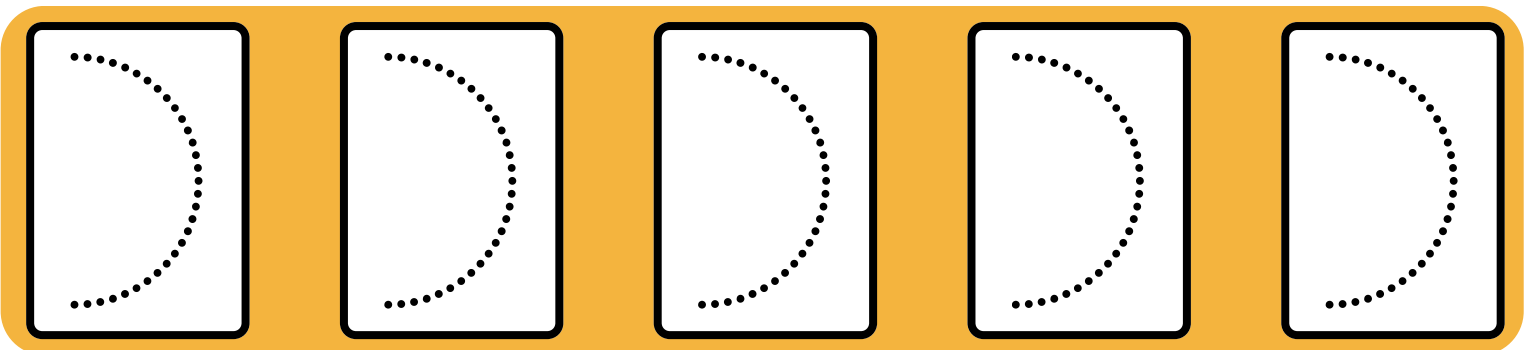
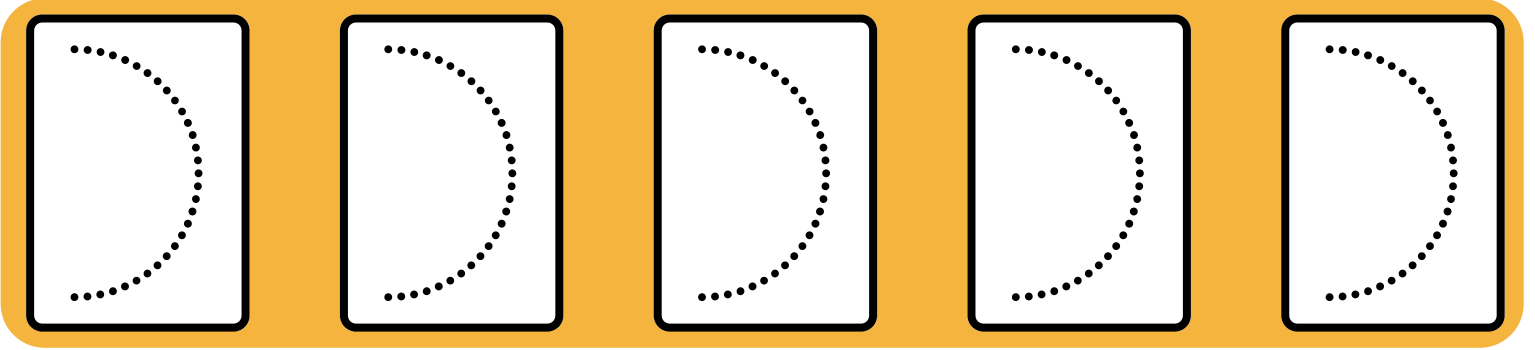
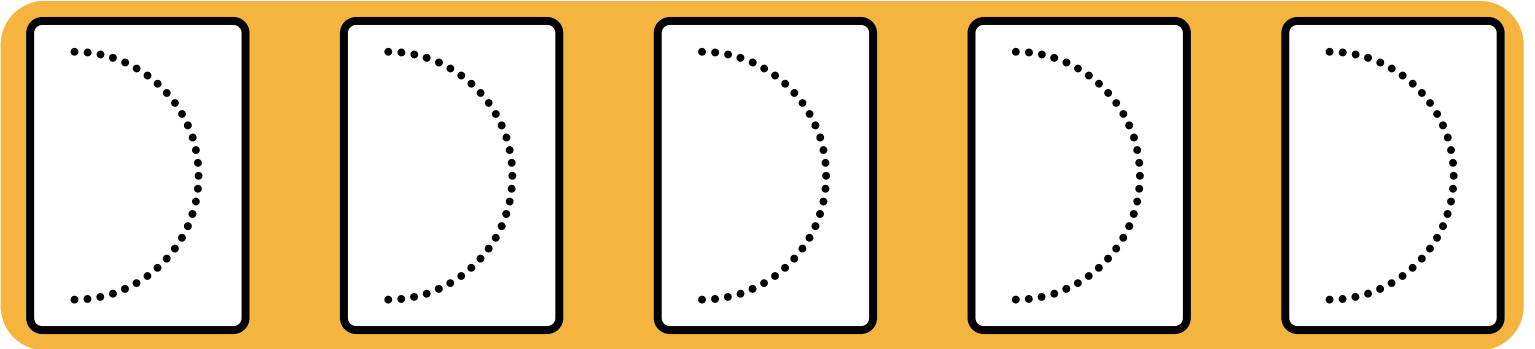
It is the opposite of the curved line you learned about. It looks backwards. Make this shape with your other hand!



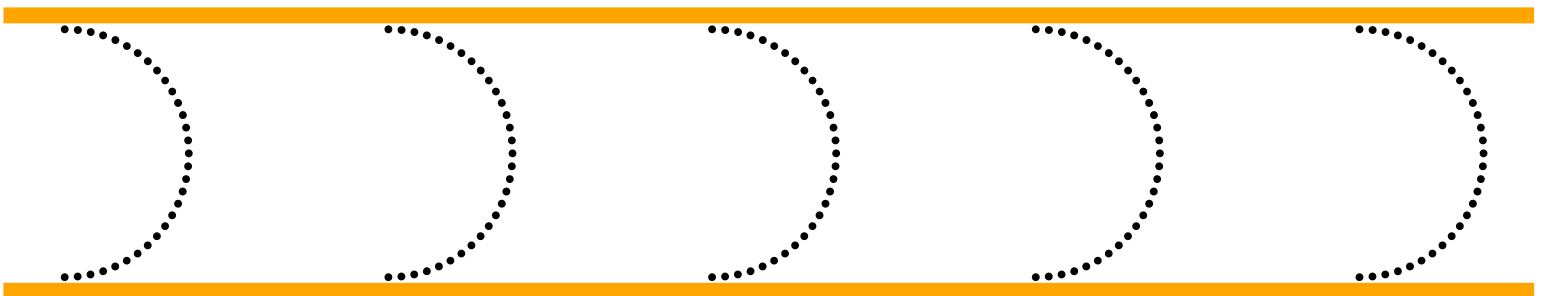
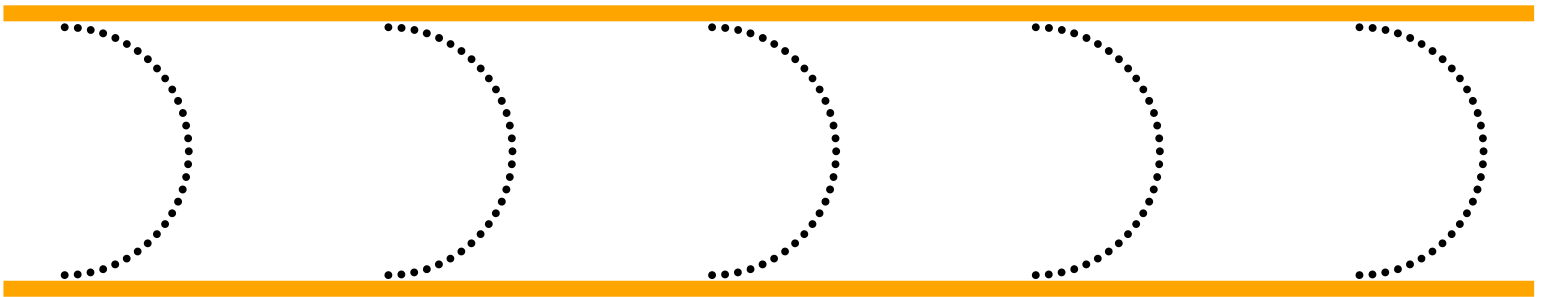
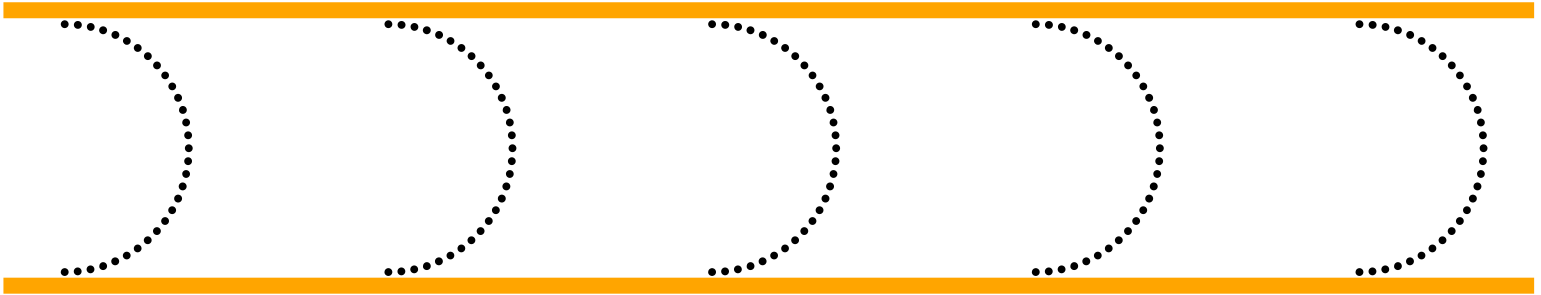
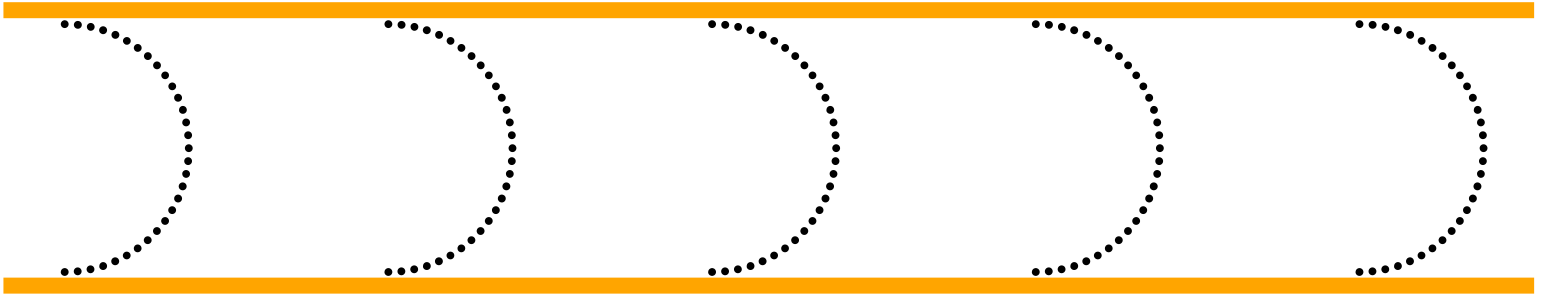
Let's trace this curved line! First, trace each one with your finger. Then trace with your pencil. Start at the top (left) and go down to the bottom (left).

Tracing practice area containing 15 dotted backward curved lines arranged in three rows of five.

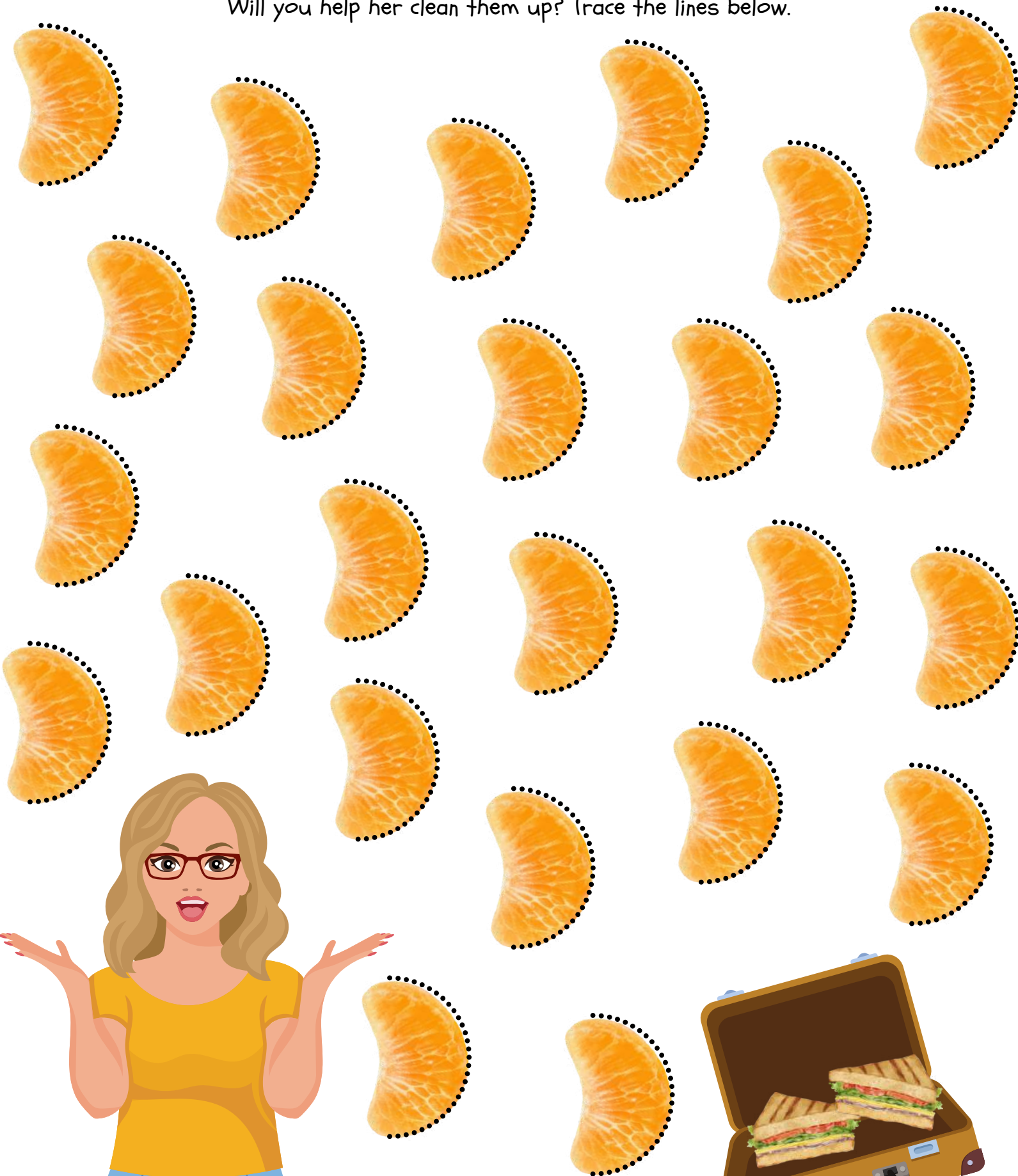
Nice work! Keep tracing!



Now trace our shapes in between the orange lines!

Let's draw our shapes! Start at the top dot and draw a curve down to the next dot.
But don't stop! Keep that line going until you get down to the bottom dot!
