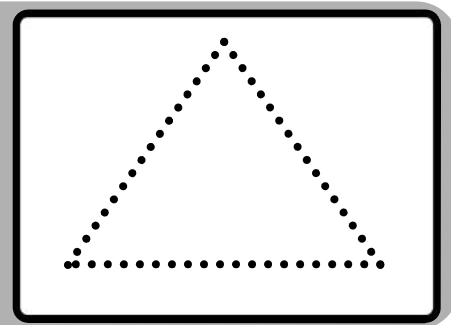
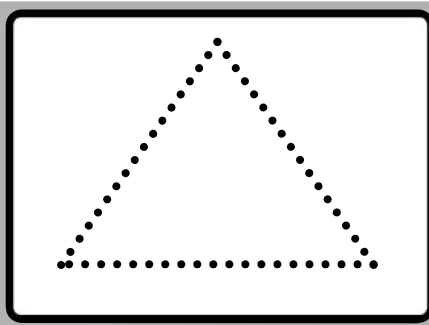
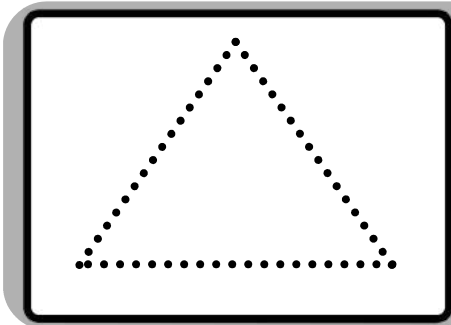
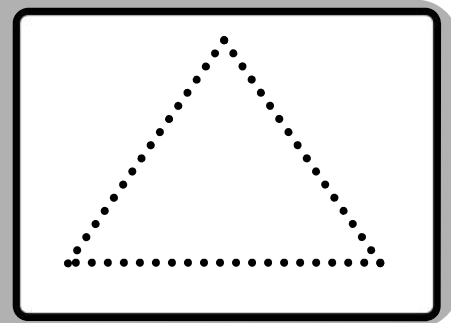
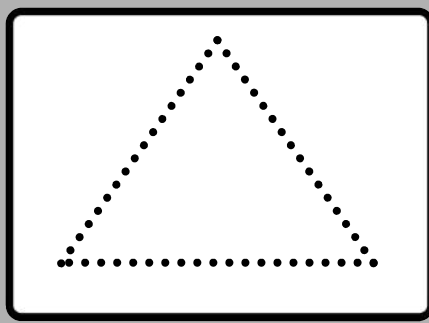
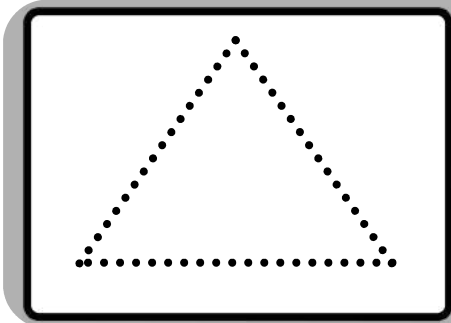
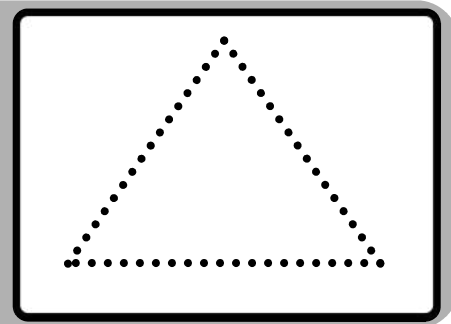
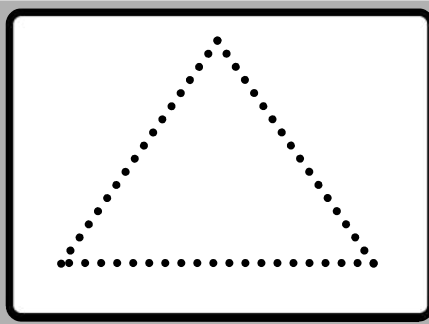
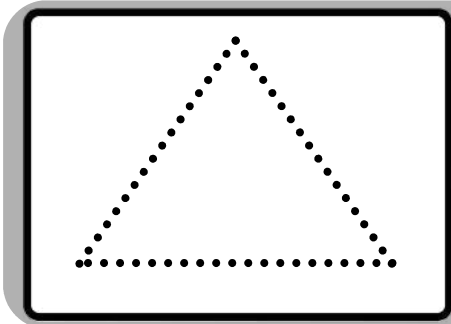
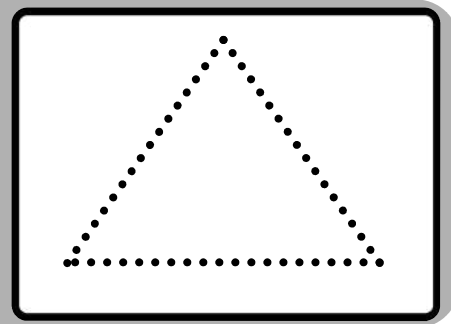
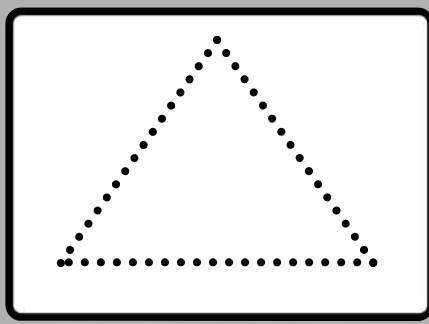
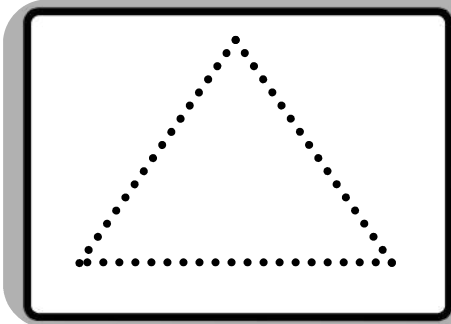
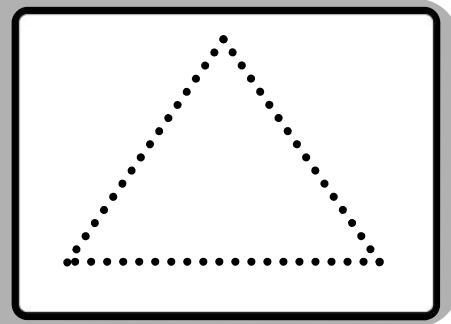
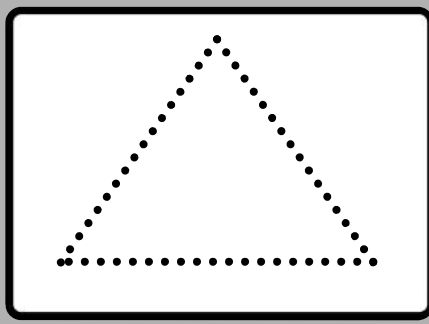
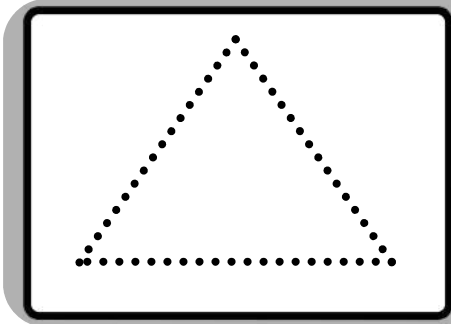


You can now trace a triangle!
