- Absolutely NO cheating is allowed!



# The Challenge:

Plan and host a dance competition according to the criteria below.

## Challenge Criteria

- Put on a dance competition that can be as short/ long and elaborate as you have time and resources for.
- You must invite at least one non-family member to participate in the competition.
- You must invite at least two non-family members to join your audience members.
- You need to designate a show host, stage manager, and dancers.
- You may use an electronic device to play music, but make sure that you put your device on "Do not disturb" and open no other apps on your device.
