### The Instructions:

### The Rules:

- NO ONE is allowed to see the challenge until the date begins!
- EVERY able-bodied person in your family must participate in some kind of capacity. Get everyone involved and make it fun! Even older babies can join in!
- You CANNOT get help from electronics unless it's mentioned in the challenge.
- You ARE allowed to have a camera or use the camera on a locked phone to take pictures/make videos of your date.
- Assign one person to be the team captain, one person to be the writer, and another person to be the photographer/videographer.
- Absolutely NO cheating is allowed!



# The Challenge:

Create a short play or skit and put it on for neighbors/non-family members.

## Challenge Tidbits

- Aim to create something that will make an impact on others.
  - For example, your goal could be to teach an important moral value. Or perhaps to help others see something from a different perspective. Or you may just want to give people the gift of laughter. Whatever you decide, put your heart into the message!
- Make this as elaborate as you have time and resources for.
  - You could do something as simple as silent acting to a song or as complex as multiple speaking parts and costumes for an elaborate play./skit.
- You may use an electronic device to play music, but make sure that you put your device on "Do not disturb" and open no other apps on your device.
