## The Instructions:

- EVERY able-bodied person in your family must participate in some kind of capacity. Get everyone involved and make it fun! Even older babies can join in!
- You CANNOT get help from electronics unless it's mentioned in the challenge.
- You ARE allowed to have a camera or use the camera on a locked phone to take pictures/make videos of your date.
- Assign one person to be the team captain, one person to be the writer, and another person to be the photographer/videographer.
- Absolutely NO cheating is allowed!

- Make this as elaborate as you have time and resources for.
  - You could do something as simple as finding certain fall items like leaves, pumpkins, etc.

  - You could keep things simple or go all out with invitations and more!
- Think about the demographic of your neighborhood before creating the hunt. Is your neighborhood full of children or is it mostly adults? Could your hunt cater to younger and older audiences? Or could it be an event that helps families work together?
- Would you have time to make this even more fun by having fall goodies to hand out?
